We acknowledge receipt of your written request of 23 February 2026 to withdraw the Environmental Statement (“ES”) for the above project submitted by Ithaca SP E&P Limited (previously Siccar Point Energy E&P Limited) to the Offshore Petroleum Regulator for Environment and Decommissioning (“OPRED”).

We hereby confirm that the ES will be treated as withdrawn from 25 February 2026.

Next Steps

OPRED will notify the Oil and Gas Authority (“OGA”)¹ that the ES has been withdrawn. However, Ithaca SP E&P Limited should also ensure that they have fulfilled any requirements regarding the withdrawal of the associated application for consent that was made to the OGA.

The status of the ES will be confirmed as withdrawn on the OPRED website at <https://www.gov.uk/government/collections/eia-submissions-and-decisions-2021> and at <https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/cambo-phase-1-field-development>.

However, for transparency purposes the submitted ES will not be removed from our website, but its withdrawal will be clearly stated. OPRED will also inform the relevant authorities consulted that the ES has been withdrawn.

Regulation 13 applied to the project because the Secretary of State considered that the project could have a significant effect on the environment of the Faroe Islands. OPRED will inform the Faroe Islands that the ES has been withdrawn.

It is recommended that Ithaca SP E&P Limited update their website to indicate that the Cambo Phase 1 Field Development ES has been withdrawn, which may include a redacted version of this letter.
